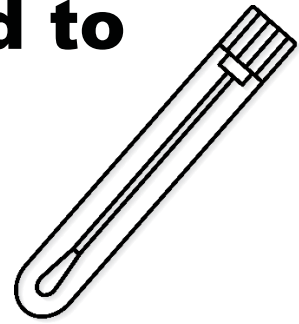


# Have symptoms or exposed to someone with COVID-19? Get FREE testing.



## 1. Get a test if you have symptoms or if you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19



COVID-19 symptoms may include **cough, shortness of breath or trouble breathing**, as well as fever, chills, fatigue (feeling tired), muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or new loss of taste or smell. This list does not include all possible symptoms of COVID-19.

If you have symptoms of COVID-19, stay home, isolate yourself from others as soon as possible, and get a test to find out if you have COVID-19.

If you don't have symptoms but spent 15 minutes or more within 6 feet of someone who tested positive for COVID-19, you should get tested for COVID-19. Stay home until you find out the results.

## 2. Make an appointment



To make an appointment, **contact the test site first** to make sure you can get a test.

## 3. Testing is confidential



Your privacy is important to us. All your health information is kept private and confidential as covered by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

## 4. Testing process

The COVID-19 test is taken with a **nasal swab** with no needles or blood samples required.
